








Energy in NL - What does the public think?¹





- 18% of Dutch population: Energy in top-5 of relevant issues
- 68%: climate change is a major problem
- However: large overestimation of contribution of renewable energy (39%.. - reality is 6%)

- 24 June 2015, URGENDA
 won against the Dutch state
 -> 25% in 2020
- 26 November 2015, Motion for phase-out of coal fired power plants accepted in parliament




Energy goals and interests

- COP 21, Paris:
 - 195 countries agreed to limit global temperature rise to well below 2°C.
- The Energy Union Europe:
 - Making energy more secure, affordable and sustainable
- Groningen natural gas:
 - Production restriction to minimise earthquakes
- Smaller Dutch gas fields (onshore and offshore)
 - Getting at end of productive life in next decade(s)
 - Security of supply increasingly important



Energy report 2023 - 2050



- January 2016: longterm vision on Energy
- Towards a low-carbon energy economy that is safe, reliable and affordable
- 1. Focus on reducing CO2
- 2. Innovation and economic opportunities
- 3. Energy as part of spatial planning



Energy report – 4 functions of energy












Predicting 2050 is impossible However, CCS is a robust element





Follow up: the Energy Dialogue

- From vision to actions: April June 2016 dialogue with society
- Focus on 2023-2030-2050
- Deliverable end 2016: Energy Policy Agenda including societal actors
- Attention for: safety, affordability, reliability and economic opportunity





Short term - URGENDA - coal fired power

- Interdepartmental Policy Research (IBO) cost efficiency of CO₂ reduction measures¹
 - Adequate CO₂ pricing important mechanism for emission reduction
 - Closing down NL coal fired power will lead to imports CO₂ emissions on European scale might benefit only little
 - Potentially: closing of two 1990's coal fired power plants but impacts biomass cofiring as well
 - ROAD is mentioned as a cost-effective additional measure
 - Decisions on measures proposed in IBO in autumn

Appeal URGENDA

Focus on national action is contrary to nature of the problem.



In the meantime ...

- ROAD still standing.
- CATO still standing. National and European research projects ongoing
- CO2 capturing at Waste Incinerator of AVR planned (see <u>www.co2-cato.org</u>)
- CO2 capture pilot at Waste Incinerator of Twence http://co2sbc.eu/
- OCAP and WarmCO₂ delivering about 500 kton/year CO2 -> greenhouses





In the meantime ...

- Participation in European collaborations, ACT, ECCSEL, North Sea Basin Task Force, ZEP...
- ... and international: CSLF
- Update of national transport & storage plan expected 2017

- Energy report puts CCS into the right perspective
